

# JESUS FORETOLD OF THE ZIONIST MOVEMENT AND HE USED DEMON POSSESSION AS BASIS FOR THE PROPHECY!

*Thus Jesus condemned Zionism before it even emerged!*



Christian Zionism holds the belief that the present Israel, since May 14, 1948 from the UN mandate given, was an act of God blessing Jewry with letting them return to their ancient homeland.

This concept is the opposite of what is the real truth and facts regarding Israel and the land of Palestine.

Israel today is in the land illegally, seen with the eyes of the Lord. I shall give you a number of reasons for that in a little while.

But first let us have a closer look at that prophecy Jesus uttered – and which He willfully tied to a case of demon possession! A possession which ‘allows’ Israel to kill children in Gaza and other places and civilians otherwise. A constant genocide is happening, even by the aid of mighty USA which sends them money and weaponry. It is a disgrace and a blasphemy against God.

**MATTHEW 12 AND THE DEMON POSSESSED MAN**

This special incident occurred in verses 22 to 45, and the drive of this case is obviously the dispute between Jesus and the Pharisees present. The dispute ending with verses 43-45 in which the Lord gives His prediction of a future Israel illegally occupying the land which they first should be cast out of. My quotes are from Amplified Bible Expanded Edition 1987, unless otherwise noted.

*22: Then a blind and dumb man under the power of a demon was brought to Jesus, and He cured him, so that the blind and dumb man both spoke and saw.*

Already here, before Jesus spoke His prophecy in verses 43-45 – we already find the metaphor coming up to the surface, which Jesus would expand upon:

Israel's infamous blindness, experienced at least since the times of the apostles. Paul quoting Is. 6 to the Sanhedrin in Rome in Acts 28:25-26 of their being blind, deaf and unrepentant...a bitter truth which has followed Jewry in the dispersion up to this very day.

The crowds seeing this great miracle performed by Jesus got excited, to the extent that the Pharisees present became jealous and angry, and began to accuse Jesus of Satanic sorcery:

*24: ...this man drives out demons only by and with the help of Beelzebub, the prince of demons.*

Jesus made the foolishness of the Pharisees evident in the eyes of the crowd, saying among other things:

*26: And if Satan drives out Satan, he has become divided against himself and disunified; how then will his kingdom last or continue to stand?*

In verse 31 we find Jesus telling the Pharisees straight out: Blasphemy against the Holy Spirit will not and cannot

be forgiven, ever. Having said in verse 28 that He cast out the demon by the power of the Holy Spirit, we clearly understand this judgmental statement from Jesus, and that the Pharisees were simply lost for all eternity because they blasphemed the Holy Spirit by saying that it was Beelzebub!

From verse 43 Jesus turns His mind and words entirely towards the future sinful disobedient aggressive Israel – and the case with the demon possessed man is the basis for His chastisement of the Pharisees. And through this stern speech we learn that the future Israel will turn worse in their fall away from God, than when God first cast them out of the land in 70 AD by the Roman Army.

*43: But when the unclean spirit has gone out of a man, it roams through dry (arid) places in search of rest, but it does not find any.*

By first impression it may seem that this is a lecture on demons in general. But this is not so: In Matt 8 Jesus experienced several demons cast out of the two wildly possessed men who held house in some tomb caves in the district of Gadarenes, and it ended by the demons taking the flock of hogs there, which then immediately ran straight into the lake and drowned. In other words, the demons did not seek some dry place, but the opposite: Water. So when Jesus not long after that had the dispute in Matt 12, it is evident that the demon cast out of that blind and dumb man, was not lectured about in a general term, but in a special one. Jesus spoke of Israel in the future: Out of their land (house) seeking and in unrest for centuries.

Moses said, Deu 28:65 – *And among these nations you shall find no ease and there shall be no rest for the soles of your foot; but the Lord will give you there a trembling heart, failing of eyes (from disappointment of hope), fainting of mind, and languishing of spirit.*

We got the proverbial word of the 'Wandering Jew' – always on the run seeking rest, finding none. Yes – but after a long time of wandering in places of unrest, they found that they would return to the house from which they had been cast out.

This is an accurate description of the Jews in the dispersion since 70 AD. Lasting for almost 2000 years now, and counting (65% of Jewry is NOT in the land). This scattering of the destroyed nation since 70 AD is what Jesus had in mind by *metaphorically* using the one demon He first had cast out of the man. But then something strange happens...

*44: Then it says, I will go BACK TO MY HOUSE FROM WHICH I CAME OUT. And when it arrives, it finds the place unoccupied, swept, put in order, and decorated.*

Of all the incidents we can read from the Bible in the New Testament, there is no one like this one. We learn of no other demon which had turned around and entered into a delivered person who had this same demon possessing him earlier.

Jesus therefore, was not speaking of demons having the ability and/or the possibility to re-possess a person. Reading of the Lord's apostles gives us no such incidents. When demons were cast out, they stayed out! So also did this particular demon in Matt 12, of course. The 'return' of that demon, was only in a metaphor and not concerning the delivered man.

Jesus spoke of this returning demon *metaphorically* as the future Israel.



And we could only understand this by the fact that this prediction is now history. Theodor Herzl, the Jewish Vienna based journalist in the late 1800s, had begun together with financial support from the Rothschild dynasty to propagate for getting back the land of Palestine as a national home to the Jews of the world. IMAGE: The occult 'Star of Remphan' a Satanic symbol of the numerical magical value of 666. The Zionist's official logo in their flag!

This early Zionist Movement can be equaled to what Jesus said in the quoted verse: The 'demon Israel' SAID, I WILL GO BACK TO MY HOUSE FROM WHICH I CAME OUT. And Rothschild funds bought several pieces of Palestinian land parcels, to start with. The Zionist Jews at this stage discovered that the land, even if only a few gentile farmers and Arab tribes used the soil, was considered by them to be *...unoccupied, swept, put in order, and decorated.*

So then, everything seems ready and settled for Herzl and company to just go in there and start building homes, settlements and eventually new towns, right?

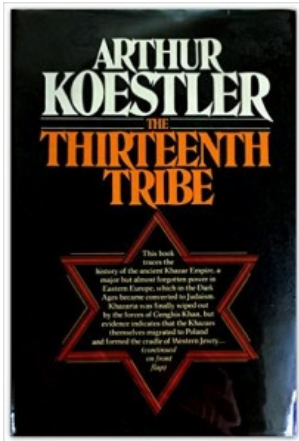
No folks, not at all. It is a lot more complicated than that. Jesus knew...

*45: Then it (the 'demon' Israel) goes AND BRINGS WITH IT SEVEN OTHER SPIRITS MORE WICKED THAN ITSELF, and they go in and make their home there. And the last condition of the man becomes worse than the first. SO ALSO SHALL IT BE WITH THIS WICKED GENERATION.*

### **THE SEVEN OTHER EVIL SPIRITS MORE WICKED THAN ITSELF – WHO ARE THEY?**

Did you know that only 3-4% of the Israelis in the land are of the gender of Abraham? The remaining 96-97% are of gentile gender, namely from the Khazars of old, since the

reign of King Bulan, today most often called Ashkenazy Jews. In modern times they occupied much of Polish land and their neighbors. Bulan had the nation converted into Babylonian-Talmud beliefs and he sent for 200 Jewish rabbis from the synagogues in Europe to come teach them Talmud religion. This all took place around 720-740 AD.



Jewry has tried to keep the history of the Khazars hidden from public knowledge, but since the famous book of Arthur Koestler, “The Thirteenth Tribe” – the knowledge has been spreading widely in the whole world. The National Library in Washington D.C. has several volumes of Khazar history. The Khazar kingdom was destroyed by Genghis Kahn’s armies.

These seven other demons more wicked than itself, – seem to be the Khazars. For we find them in Israel today in the majority! Why are they more wicked? Their history testifies to us of dark cruelty and bloodthirst, they spared no one and slaughtered not only soldiers of their enemies, but also much of the civilians. They certainly have bad traditions from ancient times.

Menachem Begin, Aaron Sharon, Benjamin Netanyahu and most others among Israeli leadership over the years were/are Khazars – which is same as Ashkenazy folks. Gentiles converted into Jews. Also in USA we find many Khazars, and of course in Europe not the least.

Much more could be said of these matters, but I think my pointing out of Matt 12:43-45 is sufficient for anyone of you to see clearly how Jesus actually foretold of the coming Zionist Movement.

The association with DEMON POSSESSION is pretty accurate. For like demons, the Zionist Movement Israel, are destroyers

and killers; they mock their surrounding neighbors and keep killing them (Gaza wars, etc.) – a systematic calculated genocide right before our nose-tips. Evil murdering demonic related frauds that want the world to think they are of Abraham and only want the land back since their forefathers owned it in olden times.

But Jesus will once again drive out the demon of the Israeli house.

This shall happen when He sends the Great Tribulation upon them, before too long. Most of the Revelation Book is about this scaring event. It will come.

Zach 13:8 says of that event that only one third of the population shall be saved, and two thirds are going to perish, as the Lord will have them killed/executed for their evil deeds and disobedience against Him, Jesus Christ.

Moses' words shall be fulfilled: *And you shall be left few in number, whereas you had been as the stars of the heavens for multitude, because you would not obey the Lord your God (Christ).* Deu 28:62.

But this little remnant of Jews from the horrible time of the tribulation, shall enter the new kingdom and be together with Christ in the millennia prophesied. Dan 2:44; Rev. 20:4.

Seeing that Christ used this incident with a demon possession to prophesy of the Zionist Movement, we must



thereof understand that this event was unwanted by God. This was not God acting and 'blessing' Israel letting Jews and Khazars enter the land, no more than it would be a blessing from God to get yourself demon possessed!

Jesus has therefore left us His word so that we will understand the evil nature of the Zionist Movement, and also understand why God will deal so harshly with them by sending the Great Tribulation judgment.

Stay clear of all forms of Zionism, and Christian Zionism. The whole concept is demonic! Also will be the soon coming false Messiah called anti-Christ of Rev. 13.

### WHAT WERE THE REASONS FOR GOD TO DESTROY AND SCATTER ISRAEL IN 70 AD?

I just want to have a closer look at what exactly laid behind the destruction of Israel in 70 AD.

Studying the Bible reveals to us at least **two specific reasons** for such an act of judgment from God.

In the outwardly, it may seem to the average man that the nation was destroyed simply because they rebelled against the mighty Rome. It was initiated by Jewry, or fractions of Jewry, in the land.

There were two 'candidates' that stood forth saying that they were God's chosen Messiah...and they raised a considerable uproar against Roman rule. These are mentioned in Josephus books 'The Jewish War'.

But as it were, Rome was but a tool or a weapon in the Lord's hands to chastise the fallen nation, ultimately having them destroyed and scattered in the world.

Paul taught of the Roman rulership (as a nation used by God for punishments) and said in Rom 13: 2-4:

*Therefore he who resists and sets himself up against the authorities resists what God has appointed and arranged (in divine order). And those who resist will BRING DOWN JUDGMENT UPON THEMSELVES (receiving the penalty due them). 3: For civil authorities are not a terror to (people of) good*



*conduct, but to (those of) bad behavior. Would you have no dread of him who is in authority? Then do what is right and you will receive his approval and commendation. 4: For he is God's servant for your good. But if you do wrong be afraid, for he does not bear and wear the sword for nothing. HE IS GOD'S SERVANT to execute His wrath on the wrongdoer.*

This was written of the Roman Empire and it's standing before God. It was used by God to control Jewry at that time. That is why we, in Matt 22, will see that Jesus called this Roman power for 'The Kings Armies' (Himself as the king). In English Bibles it often says soldiers, but in Norwegian and other Bibles, it says armies.

Jesus gives us two specific parables, which pointed to the destruction:

The parable of 'The King's Servants' in Matt 22 and the parable of 'The Fruitless Figtree' in Luke 13.

### **THE PARABLE OF THE 'KINGS SERVANTS'**

Matt 22:3-7 reads:

*And He sent His servants to summon those who had been invited to the wedding banquet, but they refused to come. 4: Again He sent other servants, saying, Tell those who are invited, Behold, I have prepared my banquet; my bullocks and my fat calves are killed, and everything is prepared; come to the wedding feast. 5: But they were not concerned and paid no attention, and they went away – one to his farm, another to his business. 6: While the others seized His servants, treated them shamefully, and put them to death. 7: Hearing this, the king was infuriated; and He sent His soldiers and put those murderers to death and burned their city.*

Those in verse 3 were the disciples as seen in Luke 10:1-16 sent out to towns in Israel before Jesus was killed. Jesus

said to them at that time: Those who rejects you, rejects Me! Those in verse 4 were the disciples sent forth as apostles from the day of Pentecost in Acts 2. The persecution and killings mentioned in verse 6 are that which happened to the apostles and their assembly.

We notice in the parable, the king became very angry and sent forth His armies to deal with the evildoers that persecuted and killed several of His apostles. Most of whom we can read in Acts. In addition to Acts, Josephus testifies of the Sanhedrin killing the brother of John, James – in 64 AD, causing the entire Jerusalem assembly to head for Pella up north in Israel. And, Jesus said in His parable: The armies burnt their city, which of course was Jerusalem as we know what happened in 70 AD. Jesus Christ used the Roman armies to destroy Israel, to drive out the 'Demon Israel' from the land – like He foretold in Matt 12 and the demon-case mentioned, like a metaphor.

### **THE PARABLE OF THE 'FRUITLESS FIG TREE'**

Luke 13:6-9 reads:

*A certain man had a fig tree, planted in his vineyard, and he came looking for fruit on it, but did not find any. 7: So he said to the vinedresser, See here! For these three years I have come looking for fruit on this fig tree and I find none. Cut it down! Why should it continue also to use up the ground. 8: But he replied to him, Leave it alone, sir, just this one more year, till I dig around it and put manure on the soil. 9: Then perhaps it will bear fruit after this; but if not, you can cut it down and out.*

The earthly ministry of Jesus was for three years, as He said in the parable. The fruit He mentions is equal to faith in Him as their Messiah of God. But He could not find fruit in Israel, the fig tree, as a nation. Only a minority had faith, as we read in Acts. Reading the Gospels and the Book

of Acts we simply have to admit the bitter truth: Israel – even after over 30 some years, said a final ‘No thanks’ to Jesus as Messiah.

It was the apostles in history who made up the voice of the vinedresser in this parable. The manure put on the soil was their preaching and teaching of Jesus as Israel’s Messiah King, to come from heaven as soon as the nation had repented and been baptized, Acts 2:38.

The apostles taught the New Covenant in the blood of Jesus, according to Jer 31:31-34. See Hebr 8 and 9 chapters. And that requirement of ‘One extra year’ to make the fig tree recover, – was the 30 years of Acts history – but which ended with the final fall of Israel. God cut all contact as we see the Book of Acts closed, with Paul’s stern quoting of Is 6 of Israel’s blindness, deafness and unbelief. That year can be counted as an extra ‘Acceptable year of the Lord’ as we read in Is 61:2 – which equaled about 30 years in the calendar. But it ended with judgment, as the Roman battle axe cut down the fig tree, Israel, for it was not allowed anymore to use up the ground for no good reason. Unless Israel, the whole nation (!) has faith in Jesus, they cannot lawfully own and use the land.

What is left in our time, as we are still into the present church dispensation of the free grace salvation of Christ by faith (Eph 2:8), – is that God will let it run just a little more time...to see the sins of Israel piled up and running over for judgment. And when it reaches that utmost measure (Dan. 8:23), so that the Lord cannot stand it anymore, He shall conclude this dispensation by taking us into heaven (Col 3:1-4), and the same day He shall send down Elijah and Moses (Rev. 11) to administer the Great Tribulation in Israel, prophesying doom and frightening signs as we find in the Revelation Book.

**PAUL CONFIRMING MATT 12:45 WITH DETAILS**

2 Tim 3 was written to Timothy when it still was Israel and the offer to them of the New Covenant. At that time Israel was still God's nation on earth, and He had given the nation time to repent and be baptized, so He could send Jesus back from heaven to establish the promised millennial kingdom in Israel.

But Paul was given insight by the Lord to know the implications of the downfall of Israel, and the nation getting worse than ever in the end times. So we read:

JESUS: *The last condition of that man (Israel) becomes worse than the first. So also shall it be with this wicked generation. Matt 12:45.*

PAUL: *...that in the last days will come perilous times of great stress and trouble 2: for people will be lovers of self and self-centered, lovers of money (is it not Jewry which has become infamous throughout history of acting as usurpers?) and aroused by an inordinate desire for wealth, proud and arrogant and contemptuous boasters. They will be abusive (blasphemous, scoffing), disobedient to parents, ungrateful, unholy and profane.(think of Talmud's blasphemy against Jesus!). 3: without natural affection (callous and inhuman), relentless slanderers, intemperate and loose in morals and conduct, uncontrolled and fierce, haters of good. 4: treacherous (betrayers), rash, inflated with self-conceit, lovers of sensual pleasures and vain amusements more than and rather than lovers of God. 5: For although they hold a form of piety, they deny and reject and are strangers to the power of it (to Jesus Christ). Avoid such people..... (The red text is my comment).*

I end the quote here. Leaving it to the reader to read the rest if you wish. It is all a disgusting matter – the downfall of Jewry is one big black hole – and that is why Paul admonished us to keep distance!

Eph 5:11 was written to us in the matter of keeping away from having any fellowship with such people:

*Take no part in and have no fellowship with the FRUITLESS DEEDS (remember Luke 13 and the fig tree?) and enterprises of darkness, but instead expose and reprove and convict them.*

But 2 Tim 3:9 was pointing to when Jesus comes from heaven, and will unmask the evil Zionist Jewry in full publicity for the entire world to see.

*...their rash folly will become obvious to everybody...Paul prophesied.*

There is no doubt that Zionism is a cause *more affiliated with demon possessive powers* than with Godfearing conduct and faith in Christ. It is therefore we find in the Bible that Jesus shall come with fierce judgment upon them. It is a fact.
